Palliative Day Program

DCH offers its Palliative Day Program weekly. It has been expanded to appeal to more clients while providing a break for caregivers as their loved ones are well cared for. The program includes a meal and social time, as well as a specific activity that changes weekly. Clients may choose their participation level depending on how they feel. A rest area is also provided. Transportation can be arranged. Participation is limited to clients with life-threatening illnesses.

Dundas County Hospice has the best volunteers! The countless hours that DCH volunteers spend visiting clients, fundraising, helping with administrative tasks and participating on our Board of Directors is so appreciated! DCH visiting volunteers are required to complete a 30-hour Hospice Palliative Care Course, obtain a clear "Vulnerable Sector" police check and meet for a brief interview with the Director of Client Services. Every year a "Volunteer of the Year" is honoured.

Who pays?

Dundas County Hospice is a Non-Profit Organization. Approx. 55% of our budget is funded by the Ministry of Health through the Champalin LHIN. The other 45% is raised through In Memoriam and general donations, support from various local service groups, applicable grants and fundraising activities.

"In Memory of" (Memoriam) Donations:

You or your family can name Dundas County Hospice as a charity for friends and loved ones to donate in your memory. Tax receipts are issued and your family receives a card.

"In Honour of" Donations:

In lieu of a gift for that person you don't know what to buy for; anniversary, birthday, retirement or Christmas. Tax receipts are issued and a special card is sent to the honouree.

General Donations:

Donations can be mailed or dropped off to our office anytime. A note or the stub of this brochure can be sent along with your donation to ensure we have all your relevant information.
